Main Attractions

City of Murals

See the city's rich history painted on outside walls in larger-than-life proportions. Instead of turning pages of a book, you need only turn a corner to come face to face with stories of the past. This outdoor art gallery consists of 25 murals. Step-on guides are available to direct your bus to each mural and to describe what is depicted in each painting.

Historic Fort Steuben & First Federal Land Office

Step back in time to the beginning of the westward movement at the reconstructed Historic Fort Steuben, which depicts 18th century military life. Originally built in 1787, Fort Steuben helped open the Northwest Territory by protecting government surveyors who laid out the first Seven Ranges. Get a glimpse of Ohio frontier life at the First Federal Land Office, an original log cabin built in 1801. 740-283-1787 ■ www.oldfortsteuben.com

Jefferson County Historical Museum

The Jefferson County Historical Association preserves local artifacts in a nineteen-room, Tudor-style Mansion Museum. Open by appointment only. Please note, the museum is accessed by stairs.

Village of Mount Pleasant / Quaker Meeting House

Drive along Ohio's Scenic Byway to Historic Mount Pleasant and visit the quaint Quaker village and Quaker Meeting House that seats 2,000 people. Built in 1814, the meeting house contains a massive "roll up" wall partition.
